Titus 1:1-3

Paul an apostle:
Teaching truth
God is “immutable” cannot lie
Preaching is the means of communicating truth
God’s man is commanded to preach and teach the truth of God

Titus 1:4-5

Titus reminded of God’s attributes that benefits mankind
Titus given clear instructions on ministry

Titus 1:6-9

Titus given understanding on attributes of one whom God would use in ministry as an authority.

Titus 1:10-14

Titus warned to look closely because some will try to come in and deceive. These men are not easily recognized.

Titus 1: 15-16

Titus is warned that those who are evil will not see the pure.
Evil will always rebel.

Titus 2:1

Titus told to proclaim truth that is absolute

Titus 2:2-10

Titus is reminded everyone has a God given role in life.
Older to teach younger a Bible truth throughout
Lessons taught may seem to be obvious but are commanded because they are not all that naturally occurring.
Our daily life even at work should always point people to Christ

Titus 2:11-13

Titus is told to teach the gospel
Titus is told to proclaim the truth with authority

Titus 3:1-2

Titus teaches to deal with authorities with meekness

Titus 3:3-7

Titus to remind those saved where they came from
Reminded that salvation is from God and His grace
The result of salvation is eternal life, eternal security

Titus 3:8-9

Titus teaches good works a must, assurance of salvation.
Titus teaches how to work with others and what to avoid.

Titus 3:10-11

There are those who we are not to deal with
There are those who will twist the truth to confuse you

Titus 3: 12-14

Titus is given instructions for the organization of different ones serving
Different people have different ministries but all should work together

Titus is reminded to greet all who love God with open arms based upon the grace of God.
